



The Greenville Triumph Soccer Club is excited to announce the 2023 Read to Score Program brought to you by Duke Energy! By taking part in the Read to Score Program, students will have the opportunity to earn one FREE ticket to attend a Greenville Triumph match on October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at 7PM verse Lexington S.C.

With our move to Furman University's Paladin Football Stadium and increase in seating capacity, all students and teachers will have the opportunity to participate in a halftime parade around the pitch cheered on by thousands!

Each student will be asked to read 3 grade appropriate books between the dates of Tuesday September 5<sup>th</sup> – Friday September 22<sup>nd</sup>. Each student will receive a FREE bookmark to track their reading progress. We ask that you put up your teacher poster in the classroom (or other appropriate place) to track progress of students. Please ask students to check in with you each week to evaluate their progress. As each student reads a book, we ask that the poster be updated to reflect progress made by students.

Prior to the designated reading period the Greenville Triumph website will include:

- A copy of the teacher/media specialist/librarian program materials
- A poster to record progress of each student per class (hard copies will be delivered to schools)
- An informational letter to inform parents of the program
- A bookmark for each student to track individual progress (hard copies will be delivered to school)
- A congrats letter for students who complete the Read to Score challenge

Upon Completion of the program on September 22<sup>nd</sup>, please make sure all students who completed the challenge receive a congratulatory letter with further details including parking, our clear bag policy, and how to redeem/purchase tickets to the match.
