Internship Overview

The Game Presentation Intern will assist with the planning, coordination, and execution of all in-stadium entertainment and live production elements for Greenville Triumph and Greenville Liberty home matches. This internship offers hands-on experience in live event production, sports entertainment, and match-day operations within a professional soccer environment.

The intern will work closely with the Partnership Marketing & Game Presentation Coordinator and other departments to help deliver an engaging, high-energy fan experience on match days. This is a summer, unpaid internship requiring nights, weekends, and match-day availability.

This internship is un-paid and runs from **May-August 2026** and is adjustable depending on schedule.

Key Responsibilities

- Assist in the development and execution of match presentation elements for all Triumph and Liberty home matches.
- Support the creation and organization of match scripts, run-of-show documents, and in-match promotions.
- Help coordinate pre-match production meetings and assist with match-day communication among staff.
- Assist with on-field promotions, in-match entertainment, contests, and fan engagement activities.
- Support execution of partner-related match presentation elements (PA reads, promotions, signage cues, etc.).
- Assist with managing match-day staff, performers, and entertainment groups as assigned.
- Help with setup, tear down, and in-match operations for match day production needs.
- Collaborate with marketing, partnerships, and operations departments to ensure alignment on match-night objectives.
- Perform other duties related to match presentation, live events, and fan experience as assigned.

- Current student or recent graduate in sports management, marketing, communications, broadcasting, or a related field.



- Strong interest in live sports, event production, and fan experience.
- Excellent communication, organization, and time-management skills.
- Ability to multitask and adapt quickly in a live event environment.
