- ☐ Follow the official Game Day Run of Show to ensure all production elements are executed accurately and on time.
- ☐ Coordinate with the Game Presentation Director and other production staff throughout the match.
- ☐ Assist with pregame setup, equipment testing, rehearsals, and postgame breakdown.
- ☐ Troubleshoot basic production equipment issues as they arise during events.
- ☐ Maintain clear communication using radios while working in a fast-paced environment.
